We are pleased to have HUD Secretary (1993-1997) Henry Cisneros talk about equitable affordable housing opportunities and how we as leaders can work together and be the champions of creating the journey to homeownership for many low-income families in our Laredo-Webb County, Texas community. Throughout his public service, Secretary Cisneros was an advocate of human rights. At 27 he became the youngest Hispanic to be elected to San Antonio's City Council and on April 4, 1981 Cisneros, at age 33 became the Mayor of San Antonio, Texas. During his eight years as Mayor, he attracted national attention for his success in developing new economic growth in the city's business sector, and with his diplomatic skills to "promote cooperation" among the city's various ethnic groups, his efforts brought in Sea World and Fiesta Texas to name a few. In 1993 Cisneros became the first Hispanic HUD Secretary. He accomplished great transformation to HUD by streamlining 240 programs to 20, even with the attitudes of employees that made his job difficult.

As a private citizen Cisneros is active in non-profit and civic leadership. How can we bring equitable housing opportunities to our community? This will be an interesting conversation so please mark your calendars and join us at our 30th Year Anniversary Gala. About NeighborWorks Laredo

30 years later with an estimated community investment of over \$353 million dollars, we have assisted 15,631 individuals or families with affordable housing and counseling, created 3,600 new homeowners, helped 465 families from foreclosure, repaired and constructed homes, acquired or constructed rental units to offer affordable housing rents, offered lending opportunities, money management, credit improvement, and the list goes on. Our work continues and with your support, we can create equitable housing and opportunities. Our Mission and Belief: Equitable Housing is a basic human right.

NeighborWorks Laredo also known as Laredo-Webb Neighborhood Housing Services was founded in 1991 under Mayor Aldo Tatangelo's administration. The City of Laredo

applied and received a grant to establish a neighborhood housing service agency; now known as Laredo Webb Neighborhood Housing Services, Inc. In 2012 our agency started doing business as NeighborWorks Laredo, as an affiliate of NeighborWorks America.

In 1978 Congress institutionalized the NHS network by establishing the Neighborhood Reinvestment Corporation. In 2003 the NRC started doing business as NeighborWorks America. A Congressional Act charged NRC with promoting its mission as:

“Revitalizing older urban neighborhoods by mobilizing public, private, and community resources at the neighborhood level.”

As of this year, there are a total of 247 member affiliates of NeighborWorks America and NeighborWorks Laredo is proud to be part of this membership.
